Technical	SANEDI is a research and development entity established as a juristic person in terms
specifications)	of the Energy Act, Act 34 of 2008, within SANEDI exists a Supply Chain Management unit which is established to support the mandate of the institution. SANEDI's SCM consist of three (3) bid committees, namely, Bid Specifications, Bid Evaluation and Bid Adjudication Committee. There is currently a need for training of both Bid Specifications Committee (BSC) and Bid Evaluation Committee (BEC) members. The training is crucial to SANEDI and its SCM in order for the committee to sharpen their knowledge and skills so that they can deliver efficiently and effectively. Qualified and suitable service providers are requested to submit quotation.
	Scope of works
	The prospective service provider is requested to present a 2 day to 3 day in-house course to 14 members and project managers (10) of the BSC Committee. The training must be tailor made to meet the requirements of the organization and as such a facility to receive questions before the session must be made available to allow for critical questions to be raised by the attendees before the sessions and for such must be addressed as part of the training.

	✓ The establishment, structure and role of the Bid Specifications Committee (BSC)

- ✓ The importance of a Bid Specifications Committee, the SCM unit and the procurement process.
- ✓ The importance of the Preferential Procurement Regulations act requirements when compiling bid specifications
- ✓ Legislative requirements to be considered when compiling bid invitation e.g. Preferential Procurement Regulations Act
- ✓ Important information to be included in the bid and what should not be included
- √ How to set up an evaluation criteria that will give the end user goods and or services they are looking for
- ✓ Sourcing methods/strategy to be used before starting the bid invitation process
- ✓ The importance and purpose of ethics within the SCM
- ✓ Choosing the best contract type e.g. lump sum contract, fixed price contracts, cost reimbursement contracts, measurement contracts, industry specific contracts etc.
- ✓ Best practices in tender process
- ✓ Market analysis prior to bid invitation

The course (for BEC) must include:

- ✓ Summary of the public sector SCM
- ✓ Code of ethics/conduct for the BEC members
- ✓ Applying the legislative framework that is relevant to the evaluation process in order to ensure compliance
- ✓ Understanding pre-qualification
- ✓ Understanding score sheets, calculations and formulas
- ✓ Understanding the relationship between BSC, BEC and BAC and the independency of the three committees
- ✓ Applying the price evaluation points formula, as well as discounts if any
- ✓ Understanding the 80/20 and 90/10 points scoring formula
- ✓ Understanding BBBEE level evaluation and points
- ✓ Do's and Don'ts when interacting with service bidders
- ✓ Tender confidentiality
- ✓ Identifying and eliminating fraud in the tender process

The Service provider must provide all training manuals and access to presentations used during the training session.

The service provider must offer a course feedback assessment questionnaires at the end of the training and summary report on the feedback received as well as copies of the completed questionnaires and attendance registers.

Timelines

The service provider must be able to deliver the training within a month of being appointed.

Skills and competence of team

We require the services of an experienced trainer/ facilitator with at least 5 years minimum subject matter experience and training experience. Experience within the public sector will be advantageous.

Capacity and Experience of the Firm

Accreditation by a professional body of both the firm and the training is preferred.

Minimum Requirement

- Accreditation of the service provider by a professional body. (Proof must be provided)
- Accreditation of the training with the relevant a SETA (proof must be provided)

Deliverables.

- Detailed project plan incorporating schedule/timelines.
- Samples of the previous work in image format.
- Proofs for the actual work.

Timelines

The course must be delivered within a month from the date of the award.

- 4. For the purposes of this Certificate and the accompanying bid, I understand that the word "competitor" shall include any individual or organization, other than the bidder, whether or not affiliated with the bidder, who:
- (a) has been requested to submit a bid in response to this bid invitation;
- (b) could potentially submit a bid in response to this bid invitation, based on their qualifications, abilities or experience; and
- (c) provides the same goods and services as the bidder and/or is in the same line of business as the bidder
 - 5. The bidder has arrived at the accompanying bid independently from, and without consultation, communication, agreement or arrangement with any competitor. However communication between partners in a joint venture or consortium will not be construed as collusive bidding.
 - 6. In particular, without limiting the generality of paragraphs 6 above, there has been no consultation, communication, agreement or arrangement with any competitor regarding:
 - (a) prices;
 - (b) geographical area where product or service will be rendered (market allocation)
- (c) methods, factors or formulas used to calculate prices;
- (d) the intention or decision to submit or not to submit, a bid;
- (e) the submission of a bid which does not meet the specifications and conditions of the bid; or

- (f) bidding with the intention not to win the bid.
 - 7. In addition, there have been no consultations, communications, agreements or arrangements with any competitor regarding the quality, quantity, specifications and conditions or delivery particulars of the products or services to which this bid invitation relates.
 - 8. The terms of the accompanying bid have not been, and will not be, disclosed by the bidder, directly or indirectly, to any competitor, prior to the date and time of the official bid opening or of the awarding of the contract.
 - 9. I am aware that, in addition and without prejudice to any other remedy provided to combat any restrictive practices related to bids and contracts, bids that are suspicious will be reported to the Competition Commission for investigation and possible imposition of administrative penalties in terms of section 59 of the Competition Act No 89 of 1998 and or may be reported to the National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) for criminal investigation and or may be restricted from conducting business with the public sector for a period not exceeding ten (10) years in terms of the Prevention and Combating of Corrupt Activities Act No 12 of 2004 or any other applicable legislation.
